Thank you to Bill Shields and Jerry Hailey who have brought great messages to us the last couple of Sundays.

Our Pastor Call Process is ongoing, though confidentiality requirements from the PEC do not allow board members to share much information as yet. We are working closely with the PEC and actively considering some strong candidates. As mentioned before, our Moravian call process is cumbersome, slow, and time-consuming. Both pastoral candidates and the church must be given time to consider decisions that will have long-term consequences. We are anxious to share, and will share, what information we can just as soon as we can.

We all do our best to remember that God is in control in these trying times just as he was before all this came about. Please continue to pray for Fairview, our congregation, our worship, staff, boards, and officers.

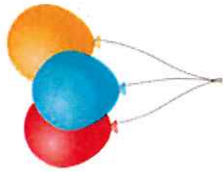

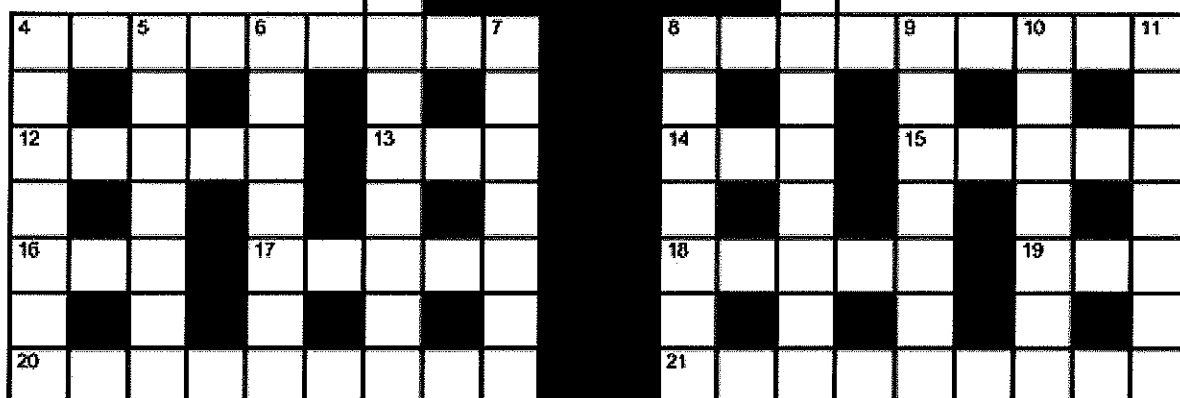
