

GENERAL LITURGY 1

(Standing)

O Lord, our Lord, your greatness is seen in all the world.

We give thanks to you, for you are good; your love is eternal.

We glorify you, majestic Lord.

We praise your holy name.

CASSELL (167 A)

Worship, honor, glory, blessing, Lord, we offer unto you; Young and old, your praise expressing, Sing your mercies ever new. All the saints in heav'n adore you; We would bow before your throne. As your angels serve before you, So on earth your will be done.

The sacrifice which you desire is a humble spirit: O God, you will not reject a humble and repentant heart.

If we confess our sins, you are just and will keep your promise; you will forgive our sins and will purify us from all wrongdoing.
