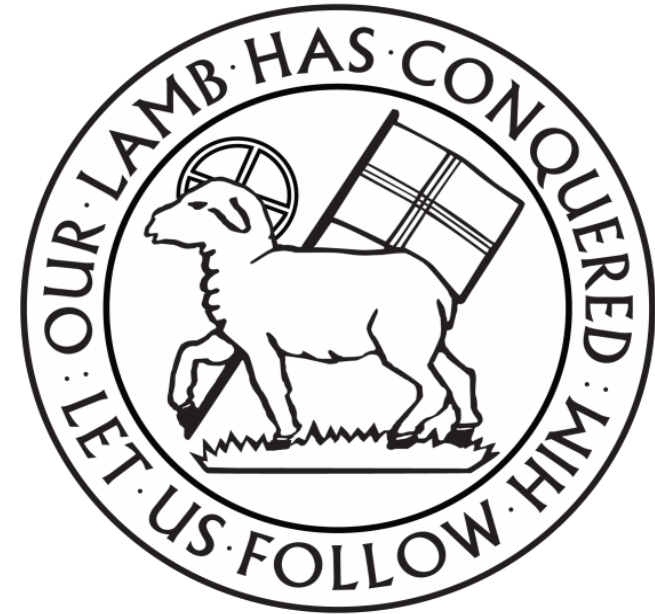
The Garden of Prayer
