INSTALLATION OF CHURCH OFFICERS

All standing, the Minister shall say and the congregation shall respond:

May our minds be responsive to your wisdom, our hearts to your love, and our service to your call. May the mystery of your glory lift us, and the knowledge of your truth lead us. Let not our minds be darkened by prejudice or ill will. Let not our souls be so dull we do not see the glow of your Spirit and your Power. Help us to discover and bring forth the best assets in every person's life, so that all may grow in Christian knowledge and hope. May all of us find in Jesus, the Way, the Truth, and the Life. Amen.
