Service at Fairview: Diener -

The Lovefeast is a simple meal of coffee and bun or sugar cake shared as a part of special worship services. Served by volunteers known as “dieners”, it is an honored Moravian tradition as a symbol of love, fellowship and trust. The Lovefeast is not a sacrament (like communion) but a way of celebrating our connectedness in the family of God. The most loved tradition of Lovefeast is served to celebrate Christmas Eve.
