LITURGY – TRUST

The Lord is near to all who call upon Him, to all who call upon Him in truth.

As for me, in the multitude of Your loving-kindness will I come into Your house: in your fear I will worship.

Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; a scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom. Lord, who shall sojourn in Your tabernacle? Who shall dwell in Your holy hill?

They who walk uprightly, and work righteousness, and speak truth in their heart.

Against You have we sinned;

O Lord, rebuke us not in Your anger.

We have transgressed and rebelled;

O Lord, chasten us not in Your displeasure.

Remember not the sins of our youth, nor our transgressions,

But have mercy upon us, O God, according to Your loving-kindness.

It is of Your mercies that we are not consumed,

Because Your compassions fail not.

Restore unto us the joy of Your salvation,

And renew a steadfast spirit within us.

And you, beloved, build yourselves up on your most holy faith; pray in the Holy Spirit; keep yourselves in the love of God; wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

The mercy of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting upon those who fear Him, and His righteousness unto our children's children, to those who keep His covenant, and remember His commandments to do them.

Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as you know that your labor is not in vain in the Lord. And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, you shall receive an unfading crown of glory.

Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honorable, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.

All: Now unto Him Who is able to us from falling, and to present us faultless before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy, to the only wise God, our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and forever. AMEN
